You will be assigned colors when you arrive at the facility.

Admission will not be charged for any events.

- **24/7 Registration: \$80/team** **Deadline: Received by February 16th**
- Please remember that the session times are approx. If we receive different numbers of teams than what we anticipate, we may add groups at another time. Please remember that there are multiple rounds of participation for this event.
- Team check-in and officials check-in will be approx. 30 min. before the starting time of the games.
- There will be no coolers allowed in the gyms. In addition, there will be no food or drink allowed in the gym. (audience or participants)
- Churches must provide line judges for the games. All line judges must be adults and male. This line judge must complete the officials training. This training will only be offered via E-learning. (www.awana4kids.org) Your team will receive 6 points if your line judge completes the training before the games, brings the certificate of completion the day of the games, and is available to help during the sessions that your team is participating in. In addition, if you register more than one 24/7 team (1 Trek & 1 Journey team) you may be asked to bring an additional line judge. This training will be available by Feb. 2nd.
- At least one coach per team must complete the coaches training. This training will only be offered via E-learning. (www.awana4kids.org) Your team will receive 6 points if its coach (the one that is coaching the day of the games) completes this training before the games, and brings the certificate of completion the day of the Games.
